

Activity 6: Endangered

For the game on the "Endangered" pages, your child will illustrate and label six endangered species on the circles provided. Then she can color the board. Ask her to tape together the game board, cut out the cards and game pieces, and then play the game with family members. It will be helpful to copy the game on card stock paper to make it sturdier. For the "Move Back" cards, encourage players to identify if the negative effect is manmade or natural. If it is manmade and the player can figure out a way to improve the situation, he or she can stay put instead of moving backward. For example, for "a new highway has disrupted native habitats," a player might suggest that land be put aside nearby for a protected habitat.

For an alternative, let your child design her own endangered species game based on information about endangered species and threats to their survival.

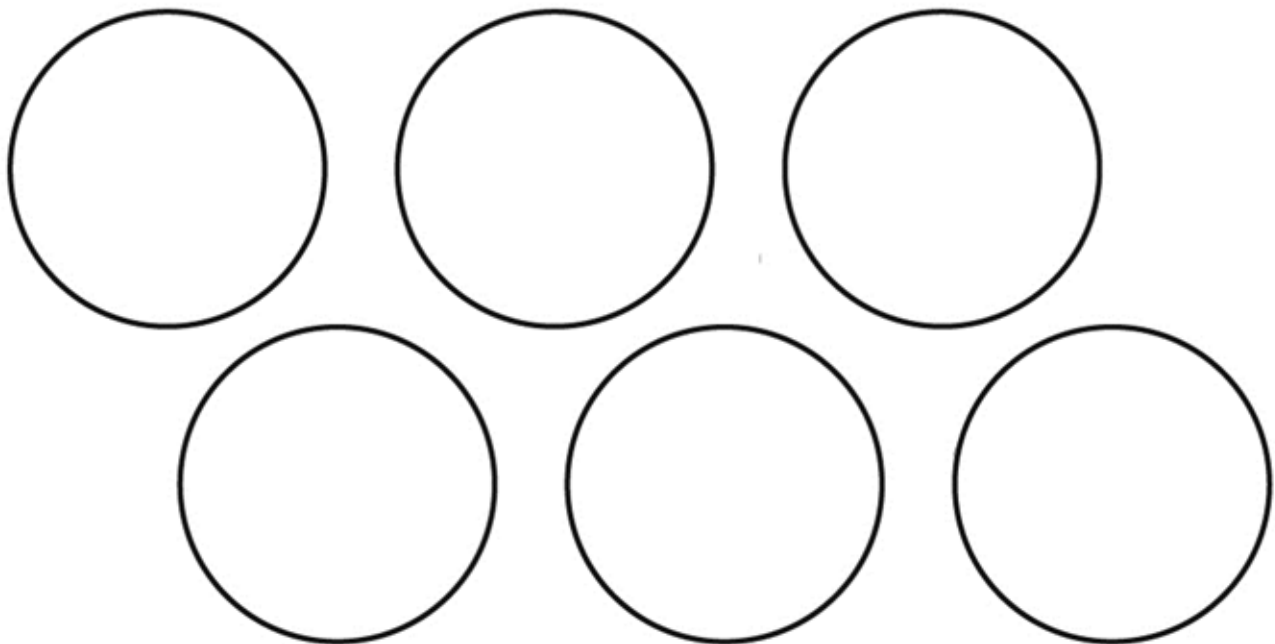
Endangered

Game Directions:

1. Each player can select an endangered species game piece and put it on the START square.
2. The youngest player goes first (play will continue with the person to the left of the first player).
3. Draw a card and follow the directions on the card.
4. Put the card on the bottom of the deck and play continues to the next player.
5. The first person to get to the end of the board survives!
