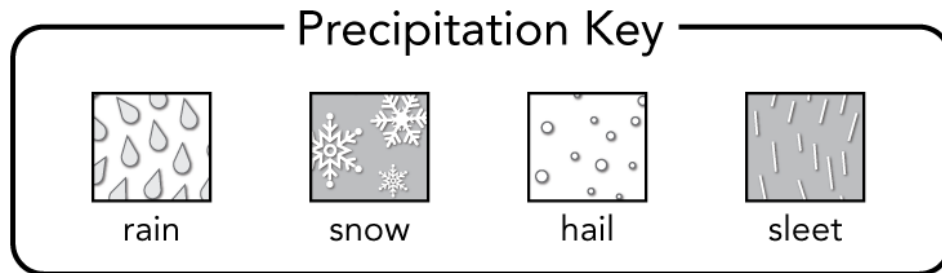


Activities

Activity 4: Precipitation Wheel

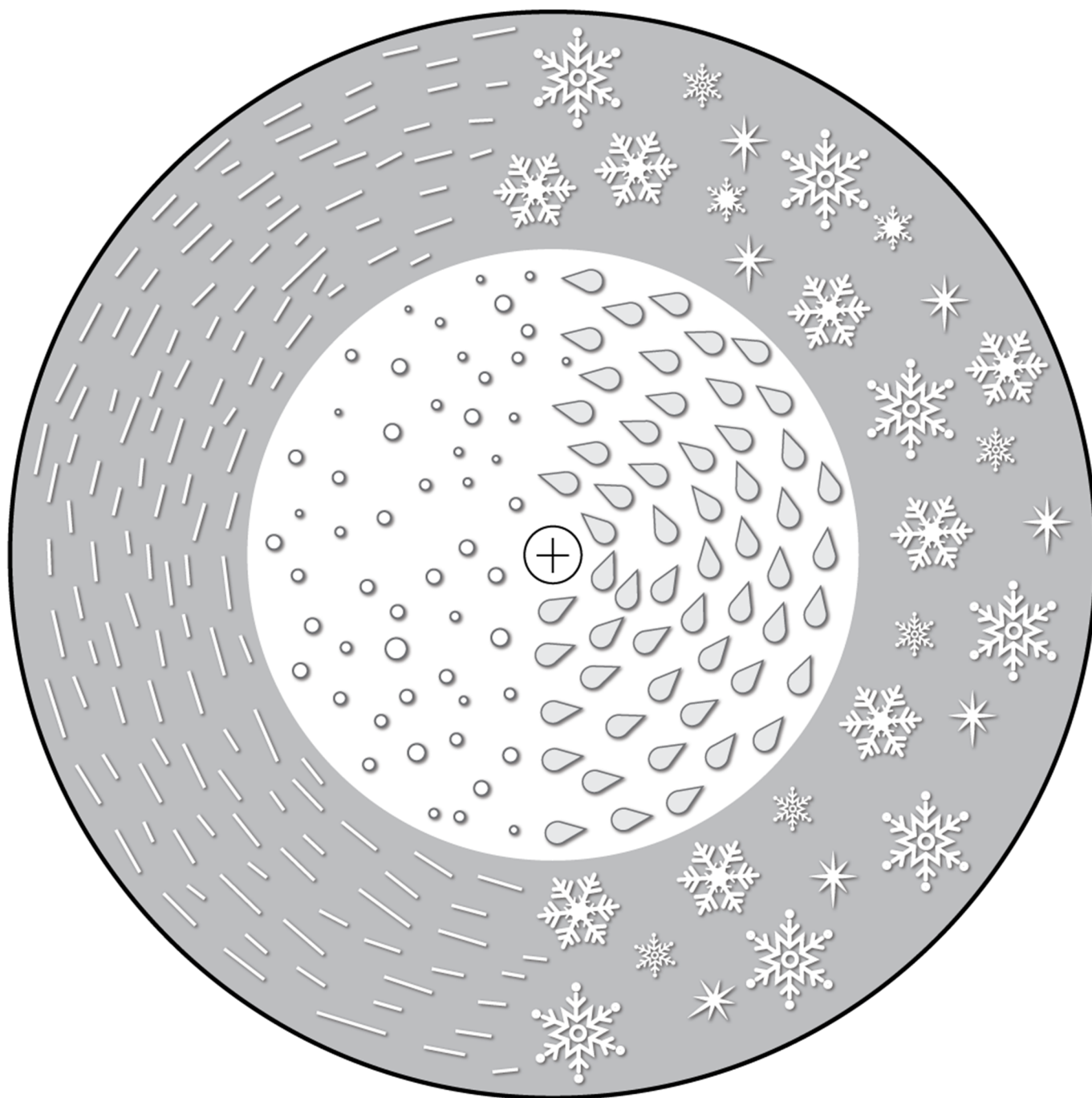
Ask your child to name the different types of precipitation — rain, snow, hail, and sleet. Ask her to explain why it rains. Review that when the water droplets that make a cloud get too heavy, precipitation falls from the cloud. On the "Water Cycle Wheel" from Lesson 3 she can label precipitation (the box pointing to the rain).

On the "Precipitation Wheel" pages she will cut out both wheels. She can color the nature scene wheel and cut out the boxes on the nature scene. Attach the precipitation wheel to the back of the nature scene using a metal brad. As she turns the wheel clockwise, she will see the different types of precipitation falling.

Directions: Cut out the wheel on this page and the following page. Cut out the boxes on the second wheel (next page), place it on top of the first wheel (below), and attach them with a brad. As you turn the wheel, you will see different types of precipitation where they might appear on a landscape.
